(C)

Where service in this Tariff is provided to the continental United States, District of Columbia, Alaska, Hawaii, Guam, U.S. Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, Mariana Islands (CNMI), as well as the off-shore areas outside the boundaries of the coastal states of the 48 contiguous states, to the extent that such areas appertain to and are subject to the jurisdiction and control of the United States, those services will be provided as Interstate services with rates equal to those provided to the continental U.S. states.
