**1. APPLICATION AND REFERENCE**

**1.1 APPLICATION OF TARIFF**

- A. This Tariff contains regulations, terms, conditions, rates and charges applicable to the provision of Carrier Common Line, Switched Access Service, Expanded Interconnection Service, and other miscellaneous services, hereinafter referred to collectively as service(s), provided by Qwest Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the Company. These services are provided to customers for resale of intrastate telecommunication services to others and to end users who utilize Feature Group A Switched Access Service-Foreign Exchange (FX) Services or Off Network Access Lines (ONAL) connected to a private line network not for resale. A Carrier Identification Code (CIC) must be obtained before customers can purchase Switched Access Service for resale.

The provision of such service by the Company as set forth in this Tariff is specifically intended to provide exchange network access to customers as follows:

- Providers of interexchange service, that furnish service between Local Calling Areas, must purchase services from this Tariff for their use in furnishing their authorized intrastate telecommunications services to end user customers, and for operational purposes directly related to the furnishing of such services.
  - Any customer, including but not limited to, telecommunications companies, and/or Interexchange Carriers, may purchase certain services from this Tariff for their own or administrative use, as specified in other sections of this Tariff. Services provided for a customer's own or administrative use may be subject to the rates and charges of other tariffs of the Company.
- B. The provision of such services by the Company as set forth in this Tariff does not constitute a joint undertaking with the customer for the furnishing of any service.
- C. The regulations, terms, conditions, rates and charges contained in this Tariff are in addition to the applicable regulations, terms, conditions, rates and charges specified in other tariffs of the Company.
