**6.2 STANDARD SERVICE OFFERINGS (CONT'D)**

**6.2.5 SPECIAL REVERSE CHARGE TOLL SERVICE**

A. Description

Special reverse charge toll service provides an arrangement whereby a subscriber enables his patrons to call him from points where a toll charge applies, without paying a toll charge and without requesting that the charge be reversed.

B. Terms and Conditions

1. This service is available only to customers having private branch exchange service or individual line service other than Public Access Line Service.
2. Special reverse charge toll service is furnished only in those exchanges where the special operating and billing methods and special telephone numbers required for that purpose are established by the Company. Such special telephone numbers include the prefix Zenith at this Company's Minnesota exchanges, and prefixes such as Enterprise, or Quickway, or Zenith at exchanges of certain other companies or in certain other States.

**6.2.5 SPECIAL REVERSE CHARGE TOLL SERVICE**

B. Terms and Conditions (Cont'd)

3. Calls for the special number are accepted only when originating at telephones located in the exchange with which the special call number is associated and only those toll calls placed by calling this special number are considered as coming within the scope of the service.
4. The customer assumes the charges for all toll calls placed by calling this special number in each exchange.
5. The initial contract period for this service is one month.
6. The message toll rates applying in connection with special reverse charge toll service are the established sent-paid station-to-station rates.
7. The monthly charges for special reverse charge toll service and associated additional listings are as follows:

#### 6.2.6 COMPLETE-A-CALL

##### A. Description

1. The Company will furnish (where facilities permit) *COMPLETE-A-CALL* whereby customers may request the completion of local, intraLATA or 800 calls to a requested number by either the Directory Assistance operator or the Directory Assistance audio response system that provides the requested directory number.

In addition, where facilities permit, business customers may subscribe to Business *COMPLETE-A-CALL*. Business customers subscribing to this service will be able to have their customers who call Directory Assistance and request their number, connected to them at no charge to their customer. They have the option of a per call charge each time a customer is connected to them (after requesting their number from directory assistance) or paying a monthly charge for each group, or fraction thereof, of 100 calls.

##### B. Terms and Conditions

1. There are no call allowances, however, the charges and call allowances for Directory Assistance are not affected and are governed by the terms and conditions in 6.2.4, preceding.
2. For local and intraLATA calls, charges for *COMPLETE-A-CALL* are not applicable to calls placed by special needs customers however, local measured service rates may apply.
3. *COMPLETE-A-CALL* applies to residence, business, and Public Access Line customers, where facilities permit.
4. *COMPLETE-A-CALL* may be alternately billed where facilities permit.
5. *COMPLETE-A-CALL* can be blocked at the originating customer's request.
6. All Operator-Handled charges apply as appropriate.
7. This service is only available for calls originating in Company exchanges.

C. Charges

1. The following charges are in addition to the Directory Assistance charge and any charge for intraLATA toll.

**6.3.16 ACCOUNT CODE BILLING**

A. Description

Account Code Billing is an offering which allows customers to allocate their intraLATA toll calls to a specific end user customer, department or dormitory student. This enables the customer to have the ability to have calls, which need to be charged to other persons or accounts, separated and displayed on their telephone bill.

B. Terms and Conditions

1. Calls billed to a third number, calling card or collect do not apply.
2. This service is only available where facilities permit and it is technically feasible.
3. Calls must be placed from a tone-signaling telephone and are identified by the user entering a 1 to 4 digit customer-defined account code for billing.
4. This service will be discontinued when a customer places their local exchange service on full suspension.
5. This service is offered, subject to the continuing availability of long distance message telecommunications facilities and capability with other services rendered by the Company having preference. The Company may terminate or refuse to furnish service hereunder, if the use of the service would interfere with or impair this or any other service rendered by the Company.
6. Call detail will be included with this plan.
7. This offering may be available with MTS Optional Calling Plans.

**6.3.17 GUARANTEED RATE CALLING CONNECTION**

A. Description

Guaranteed Rate Calling Connection provides customers the opportunity to contract for intrastate/intraLATA calls at a special rate. The customer guarantees a monthly usage level for a specified time period and is guaranteed a rate per minute associated with that level. The customer will pay the guaranteed monthly minimum usage, plus any additional usage above the guaranteed minimum usage level.

B. Rates and Charges

Individually priced contracts are available.

#### 6.3.18 CALLING CONNECTION PLANS

##### A. Description

Message Telecommunication Service (MTS) Calling Connection Plans (hereafter referred to as the Plans) are optional toll calling discount plans.

##### SUPER SAVINGS Calling Plan

*SUPER SAVINGS* Calling Plan customers will be charged a special rate, specified in C., following, for their intrastate/intraLATA dial station-to-station long distance calls, as described in 6.2.1, preceding. The Plan is available to business and residential service customers. Customers must have single or multiple, business or residential lines at single customer premises, billed on one retail bill to one billing telephone number.

##### B. Terms and Conditions

1. These Plans are not available with the following:
  - Directory Assistance Service
  - Other Company Discount Calling Plans
  - Toll Only Accounts
  - Operator Verification/Interrupt Service
  - Hearing or Speech Impairment Discount
  - *ALL TIME* Volume Discount
2. When the customer initially subscribes to or disconnects this service, if a partial month is billed, the customer's minutes and monthly rate will be prorated.
3. These Plans are available on an account level basis, where one or more lines are billed to the same account.
4. Where the customer has one account which includes multiple lines, these Plans apply to total usage of combined lines.
5. These Plans apply to all intraLATA Direct Distance Dialed, Calling Card, and Operator-Assisted calls.

**6.3.18 CALLING CONNECTION PLANS**

**B. Terms and Conditions (Cont'd)**

6. These Plans are available (where billing capabilities exist) to all business, residence and Public Access Line customers with the restrictions and limitations set forth in other provisions of this Price List.
7. The rates and charges for this service are in addition to rates and charges for the local exchange service with which it is associated.
8. The minimum service period is one month.
9. These Plans do not apply to intraLATA calls placed in another state and billed back to the account.
10. These Plans will be temporarily discontinued when the customer places their local exchange service on full suspension. These Plans will be reinstated at no charge when the customer's local exchange service is removed from suspension. The customer may elect to retain these Plans at the full rate while their local exchange service is on full suspension.
11. Unless otherwise specified herein, all Operator Assisted charges apply.
12. These Plans are available only in Independent Company territories where billing capabilities exist.

**C. Rates**

The following rates apply to Residence, Business and Public Access Line customers, per account.
