5.2 LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

A. General

1. This Section includes rules, terms and conditions and rates applicable to basic telecommunications service furnished to residence and business customers within the boundaries of the State of Minnesota as authorized by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission. Basic telecommunications service, as used in this context, refers to the various classes of Main Line Service and Extended Area Service (EAS) specified herein.

5. EXCHANGE SERVICES

5.2 LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

A. General (Cont'd)

2. Main line service provides intraexchange telecommunications service between subscribers within the boundaries of individual exchanges as designated on Exchange Boundary Maps. Main line service includes Company facilities, furnished to permit access to the telecommunications network, which extend from a central office to the Demarcation Point on the property where the subscriber is served.
3. Main Line Services are defined as follows:

- 1FR - Flat Rate Residence Service
- RWV - Measured Rate (multi-element) Residence Service
- 1FB - Flat Rate Business Service
- 1MB - Message Rate (single element) Business Service
- LMB - Measured Rate (multi-element) Business Service
- TCK - Commercial Flat Rate Central Office Trunk
- 1MZ - Public Interexchange Carrier Access Service
- 17Q - Basic Public Access Line Message Rate Service
- 1KY - Basic Public Access Line Flat Rate Service
- 5FP - Smart Public Access Line Flat Rate Service
- 1NH - Smart Public Access Line Message Rate Service

5. EXCHANGE SERVICES**5.2 LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE****A. General (Cont'd)**

4. The exchange monthly Main Line rates hereinafter specified, are payable in advance and entitle the customer in any given exchange to service to all lines connected within that exchange without other charges, except for certain messages originating from Measured or Message Rate Service, Common Carrier Service and messages subject to Directory Assistance charges. To the extent provided under EAS, and subject to the rates therein specified, payable in advance, customers within certain exchanges are also entitled to service to lines connected within certain other exchanges.
5. The boundaries of exchanges and certain territories in other states served by Minnesota exchanges are as described or indicated on maps for each exchange which are hereby made a part of this Tariff.
6. Flat rate and message/measured rate services are not furnished to customers at the same location, with the exception of:
 - a. The non-administrative, inward terminations at a Telephone Answering Bureau.
 - b. A flat rate Foreign Exchange line which is switched at a location whose calling area does not include the calling area of the normal serving exchange for the Measured Service lines.
 - c. The selection of either flat rate service or Measured Service for all administrative lines of a Miscellaneous Common Carrier or Radio Common Carrier.
 - d. Customers having a combination of metered service (1MB) and flat rate service prior to September 29, 2002.
7. Loop Diversity and/or Avoidance defined in the Private Line Transport Services Price List are available with business main line service, trunks, and semi-public message/flat rate service.

Customers subscribing to Loop Diversity must also have additional facilities for the diverse route.

Customers subscribing to Avoidance may be required to pay Foreign Central office charges, as defined elsewhere.

5. EXCHANGE SERVICES

5.2 LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE (CONT'D)

B. Application of Rates For Business and Residence Service

1. Service is classified as business service and business rates apply when any of the following conditions exist:
 - a. When the service is furnished at a location where a business, trade or practice is performed and where use of the location is not primarily for domestic activities.
 - Service for social clubs (e.g., Elks, VFW, Eagles, etc.) will be considered business service.
 - Churches will be considered business service except as specified in 2.a. following.
 - b. When the directory listing is to be a business listing.
2. Service is classified as residence service and residence rates apply when the following two conditions exist:
 - a. When the service is furnished at a location used primarily for domestic purposes; a residence location typically contains cooking and sleeping facilities.
 - Residence service will be allowed for:
 - individual rooms at group homes,
 - fraternities and sororities,
 - patient rooms at long-term residential care facilities, retirement complexes and other like facilities when using the business telephone number as their personal listing with the consent of the primary business subscriber, and
 - boarding houses when service to the rooms is not provided through a reseller of local exchange service, if the listing is in an individual's name.
 - Residence service applies to churches where the service is used in conducting affairs of that and no other church.
 - b. When the directory listing is to be a residential listing. A residence service may not have a business directory listing.
3. A residence service may not be part of a hunting sequence that contains business lines.

5. EXCHANGE SERVICES

5.2 LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

B. Application of Rates For Business and Residence Service (Cont'd)

4. Customers changing from business to residence service will be assigned a different telephone number. Referral of calls to the new residence telephone number assigned will not be provided.

Customers may choose to retain the same telephone number but must continue to pay business rates until the next telephone directory is issued in which their telephone number does not appear as a business listing.

5. When it is determined that a customer with residence service should be reclassified as business service under the above provisions, the Company will discontinue the service in the event such customer refuses to permit the service to be classified as business service and pay applicable business rates.

6. Nonrecurring Charges

- a. Nonrecurring charges, where applicable, are specified with services as stated in each section of the Tariff, unless otherwise specified or included in this section.

5.2 LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE (CONT'D)

5.2.1 MEASURED RATE SERVICE

A. Description

Measured Service is an optional local exchange service furnished with rates for an exchange access line and usage. Measured Service is available, where facilities permit, in outstate and Minneapolis/St. Paul Metropolitan exchanges. See 5.1.3, preceding, for specific offices.

B. Terms and Conditions

1. Usage charges do not apply to calls placed to the Company Business Office, Repair Service, Directory Assistance, Long Distance, or to 911 or '0' for Emergency Agencies, such as Police, Fire, Rescue or Ambulance.
2. Individual call detail will not be provided. Usage billing will be on a bulk basis.
3. For purposes of this Measured Service offering, the maximum residence Measured Service monthly billing for fixed monthly service charges and usage charges for sent paid local calls originating on the measured line will not exceed 125% of the current residence flat rate charges in that exchange.
4. The quotation of "time and charges", direction of messages, and the associated charge to be billed the customer will not be provided on local messages.
5. The timing of local messages is the same as specified for toll messages in Section 6 of the Exchange and Network Services Price List.
6. A charge will apply for Local Station-to-Station calls placed from Measured Service Lines which require operator assistance, in addition to usage charges listed above. Handicapped exemptions will apply to all sent-paid calls as specified in Section 6 of the Exchange and Network Services Price List No. 2.
7. A charge will apply for Local Person-to-Person calls placed from Measured Service Lines, in addition to usage charges listed above. These charges and terms and conditions will be as specified in Section 6 of the Exchange and Network Services Price List No. 2.
