- b. The 3 Hour Package includes 180 minute usage allowance. The method of applying the usage allowance is as follows:

- The usage allowance is applied only toward sent paid usage charges.
- No credit is given for any unused allowance during a billing month, nor is any unused allowance accumulated and/or carried forward over billing months.

- c. The 3 Hour Package additional usage charge is for each sent paid local calling minute exceeding the package rate. The timing of local messages is as specified.

- d. Measured usage charges are applicable to local messages completed on a dial station-to-station basis.

- e. Measured usage charges accumulate on a monthly basis commencing on the billing date.

- e. The 3 Hour Package usage charges will not apply to calls placed to the Company Business Office, Repair Service, Directory Assistance, to toll free numbers, long distance, or to 911 or "0" for Emergency Agencies, such as police, fire, rescue or ambulance.
- f. Nonrecurring charges do not apply to residence customers converting from measured service to flat rate service.
- g. For local Station-to-Station calls placed which require operator assistance, a service charge will be assessed in addition to usage charges listed above. Rates apply as specified in 6.2.1.
- h. For local Person-to-Person calls placed, a service charge will be assessed in addition to usage charges listed above. Rates apply as specified in 6.2.1.
- i. The quotation of "time and charges", duration of messages and the associated charge to be billed the customer, will not be provided on local messages.

C. Business Measured Service

1. Description

Business Measured Service (Value Pac) is a local exchange service furnished with rates for an exchange access line and usage. It is an optional offering on a single party basis. It is limited to where facilities and equipment are available.

2. Terms and Conditions

- a. In exchanges where Business Measured Service is offered, multiparty business service is no longer offered.
- b. Nonrecurring charges, specified in 5.2.A. will not apply for conversion from measured to flat rate service.
- c. Business Measured Service usage charges do not apply to calls placed to the Company Business Office, Repair Service, Directory Assistance, to toll free numbers, long distance, 911 or "0" for Emergency Agencies such as police, fire, rescue or ambulance.
- d. Combinations of Business Measured Service and flat rate service will not be allowed on the same premises, with the exception of:
  - The non-administrative, inward terminations at a Telephone Answering Bureau.
  - A flat rate Foreign Exchange line which is switched at a location whose calling area does not include the calling area of the normal serving exchange for the Measured Service lines.
  - The selection of either flat rate service or measured service for all administrative lines of a Radio Carrier.
- e. Usage billing will be on a bulk basis.

- c. The quotation of "time and charges," duration of messages, and the associated charge to be billed the customer will not be provided on local messages.
- d. The timing of local messages is the same as specified for Business Measured Service.
- e. For local Station-to-Station calls placed from Business Measured Service lines which require operator assistance, a service charge will apply in addition to usage charges. Handicapped exemptions will apply to all sent-paid calls. These charges and regulations will be the same as specified elsewhere in this Catalog.
- f. For local Person-to-Person calls placed from Business Measured Service lines, a service charge will apply in addition to usage charges. These charges and regulations will be the same as specified in 6.2.1.
- g. Definitions of Classes of Service for local calls: Dial Station-to-Station, Operator Station-to-Station and Person-to-Person apply to local calls originated from Business Measured Service and are specified in 6.2.1.

**D. Hearing or Speech Impairment Discount**

Disabled persons who have been certified to the Company as having a hearing or speech impairment which necessitates that they communicate by a Telecommunications Device for the Deaf (TDD) - sometimes referred to as a teletypewriter or TTY device - will receive, upon written application to the Company, credit on day, evening, and certain night rates intrastate dial station-to-station calls from a certified account premises where a TDD is located.

The credit given for these dial station-to-station calls will be a 35% discount of the full day rates for 9 a.m. to, but not including, 9 p.m. weekdays, a 60% discount of the full day rate for 9 p.m. to, but not including, 9 a.m. weekdays and all hours for weekends. For certain holidays as specified below, the 60% discount will apply unless a lower rate as specified earlier in this paragraph would apply.

For a customer with more than one line or trunk, written application will be required for each line or trunk.

The billing period for this discount will be determined by the toll billing date. The customer will receive the discount at the beginning of the next toll billing period after application approval. The customer has the option of withdrawing at either the beginning or ending of the billing period. A nonrecurring charge does not apply to establish this service.

E. Measured Service Billing Options (C)

1. Description

Measured Service Billing Options will provide customers, where these services are available, several options on how local usage charges will be billed, and in which format and amount of detail the bill will be rendered. (C)

a. Local Reverse Billing (USOC LRB)

This option provides for the billing of the called party (flat or measured customer) rather than the calling party for local measured service charges.

- Individual Line Usage (USOC OMDSB) only with LRB

This option provides a summary listing of local usage per line rather than on an account total.

- Local Usage Detail (USOC OMD) only with LRB

Local Usage Detail will provide customers detail of their local incoming measured calls under several options. Detail is available separately from the bill on either paper, magnetic tape or microfiche. This option provides the following detail: the central office prefix of the calling number, connect time, duration (holding time), date of call, and amount of each local call.

2. Terms and Conditions

- a. Local Reverse Billing is available to business customers for inward calls on a per message basis. Calls must originate from telephone lines located in Company exchanges. The customer has the option of enrolling in or withdrawing from the service at either the beginning or ending of the billing period. There will be no billing of fractional amounts.

- (1) Individual Line Usage will be provided for the first line of the following arrangements:

- Multiline hunt groups
- Simulated Facility Groups
- Centrex Data Consoles and *CENTRON*
- *MARKET EXPANSION LINE* Service

It will not be provided on customer accounts with exceptions NNX-XXXX numbering, such as:

- PBX trunks

The customer has the option of enrolling in or withdrawing from the service at either the beginning or ending of the billing period. There will be no billing of fractional amounts.

- (2) Local Usage Detail is available on a total account basis only and becomes effective on the customer's billing date. The customer has the option of enrolling in or withdrawing from the service at either the beginning or ending of the billing period. There will be no billing of fractional amounts.

#### **5.2.5 LOCAL SERVICE OPTIONS**

##### **A. Hunting Service**

###### **1. Description**

Hunting Service applies for any business main line or PBX trunk arranged for hunting which allows completion of an incoming call from a line that is called but is in use to another line in the group, by means of central office equipment. Hunting applies to all but the last line arranged.

- Circular Hunt

Permits a complete hunt of incoming calls over all the lines in a Multiline Hunt Group (MLHG) regardless of which line in the group is dialed.[1]

- Preferential List Hunt

Permits an incoming call to pre-hunt over a subset or preferential list of lines within the same MLHG as the dialed number. If all lines within the preferential list are busy, the hunt continues over the remainder of the lines in the MLHG. Each line within a MLHG may subscribe to a preferential list with a maximum of 18 MLHG lines per preferential list. This service includes Circular Hunt.

###### **2. General**

- a. Business main station lines may be arranged for hunting, level hunting or similar service where, by means of central office equipment, a call to one or more lines in a group will be completed to an idle line in that group when the called line is in use.
- b. Hunting service is furnished only where necessary facilities are available. Rates for hunting service are not applicable to trunks, Centrex or *CENTRON* lines, or residence lines.

[1] Multiline Hunt Group (MLGH) is a group of lines usually associated with one directory number. A call completing to the directory number will hunt over the lines in the group until an idle line is found.

**B. Four-Wire Service Terminating Arrangement**

**1. Description and Basis of Offering**

The Four-Wire Service Terminating Arrangement permits equipment that is designed to use four-wire terminations to be connected to the Company's standard two-wire Foreign Exchange (FX) facilities toll network. While this offering contemplates the use of four-wire facilities between the local serving central office and the premises switching equipment, two-wire facilities may be used.

Transmission performance that meets the established standards of the Company will be obtained over facilities connected to a Four-Wire Service Terminating Arrangement. If a customer requests improvement beyond this, additional equipment will be provided, where facility conditions permit, subject to additional rates and charges based on the costs incurred.

**2. Rates and Charges**

The following rates and charges are for the Four-Wire Service Terminating Arrangement only and are in addition to the applicable rates and charges for the FX trunk with which it is associated.
