1.4 RATE SCHEDULE FORMAT

1.4.1 LOCATION OF MATERIAL

- A. Section 1 provides the following for all of the sections in this Rate Schedule.
- Subject Index - an alphabetical listing to find the desired section.
 - Table of Contents - a numerical listing to find the desired section and page.
- B. Obsolete Service Offerings

Obsolete service offerings are identified in the Rate Schedule by adding 100 to the current section number, i.e., obsolete items from Section 7, Dedicated Services, will be found in Section 107, Obsolete Dedicated Services. This Section is then filed behind Section 107.

1.4.2 OUTLINE STRUCTURE

The Rate Schedule uses nine levels of indentations known as Tariff Information Management (TIM) Codes, as outlined below:

1.4.3 RATE TABLES

Within rate tables, four types of entries are allowed:

- Rate Amount

The rate amount indicates the dollar value associated with the service.

- A dash "-"

The dash indicates that there is no rate for the service or that a rate amount is not applicable under the specific column header.

- A footnote designator "[1]"

The footnote designator indicates that further information is contained in a footnote.

- ICB

The acronym "ICB" indicates that the product/service is rated on an individual case basis.
