1.4 DOCUMENT FORMAT

1.4.1 LOCATION OF MATERIAL

- A. Section 1 provides the following for all of the sections in this Price Schedule.
- Subject Index - an alphabetical listing to find the desired section.
 - Table of Contents - a numerical listing to find the desired section and page.
- B. Each individual section in the Price Schedule provides a Subject Index for the material located within that section.
- C. Obsolete Service Offerings

Obsolete service offerings are identified in the Price Schedule by adding 100 to the current section number, i.e., obsolete items from Section 9, Central Office Services, would be found in Section 109, Obsolete Central Office Services. This section is then filed behind Section 9.

1.4.2 OUTLINE STRUCTURE

The Document uses nine levels of indentations known as Tariff Information Management (TIM) Codes, as outlined below:

1.4 DOCUMENT FORMAT (CONT'D)

1.4.3 RATE TABLES

Within rate tables, four types of entries are allowed:

- Rate Amount

The rate amount indicates the dollar value associated with the service.

- A dash "-"

The dash indicates that there is no rate for the service or that a rate amount is not applicable under the specific column header.

- A footnote designator "[1]"

The footnote designator indicates that further information is contained in a footnote.

- ICB

The acronym "ICB" indicates that the product/service is rated on an individual case basis.

1.4.4 USOC COLUMN

Within USOC columns, two types of entries are allowed:

- USOC

The three- or five-character code for the product or service.

- N/A

The "N/A" indicates that there is no applicable USOC.
