104. OBSOLETE RURAL NETWORK ASSESSMENTS AND OTHER SPECIAL CHARGES

104.3 RURAL NETWORK AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

A. Rural Network Assessment

1. The Rural Network Assessment has been discontinued as of September 28, 2005. The Special Assessment Charge Refund Program will be discontinued as provided for in 104.3.C.1., following, but no later than September 27, 2010.

B. Special Assessment

1. When the service is initially established and the estimated project specific labor and material costs of extending facilities to the premises exceeds \$2,300.00 per building, per premises, a special assessment nonrecurring charge will become applicable. This charge is in addition to the rural network assessment charge.
2. The special assessment shall equal the estimated project specific labor and material costs exceeding two thousand three hundred dollars (\$2,300.00), per building, per premises.
3. A special assessment will be divided equally among all initial applicants on the basis of the cost of facilities in excess of \$2,300.00 per building, per premises. The special assessment, if applicable, will apply to all applicants requesting service prior to the placement of the facilities. Customers may be eligible for a special assessment refund if conditions, specified in E., following, are met.
4. Each of the first three subsequent applicants who request service which will utilize facilities extended under previous special assessment(s) will have 1/3 of the previous special assessment(s) included in their project specific labor and material costs if:
 - The subsequent applicants' service is requested within five years of the date of connection of the facilities to which a previous special assessment applied.

A special assessment charge will be applied for all costs exceeding \$2,300.00 per building, per premises.

104.3 RURAL NETWORK AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS (CONT'D)

C. Special Assessment Charge Refund Program

1. When a customer or customers pay a special assessment charge, the customer or customers may be refunded those charges if subsequent customers are connected to the new extension of facilities pursuant with the provisions in a., b., c., d. and e., below.
 - a. The refund will be based on a prorated share of the customer's special assessment charge to establish the newly extended facilities. The costs will be developed based on a maximum of three subsequent customer premises being served by the facility.
 - b. Up to 100 percent of the special assessment may be refunded if, within five years of the date of connection to the network, three additional customers, each located at separate buildings and premises, connect to the network using the new extension of facilities.
 - c. Any or all refunds will be distributed annually following the anniversary of the original service connection date of the initial customer(s). Customers must notify the Company of any address changes to enable the Company to issue the refund.
 - d. Refunds will only be made for amounts of \$50.00 or more.
 - e. The Special Assessment Charge Refund Program is not available to developers of subdivisions or developments.
2. The collecting of special assessment charges, tracking of the refund program and refunding the prorated amounts will be administered by the Company.
