105.2 LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

105.2.4 FLAT RATE SERVICE

This service entitles customers to an unlimited number of calls within the local calling area. Incremental charges, as shown in 5.1.6, apply to service outside the exchange base rate area.

A. Residence Flat Rate Service

B. Business Flat Rate Service

• Two-Party line, each[1]	2FB	—	22.10

C. Party Line Service

1. Description

A single exchange access line which serves more than one customer. Each customer has a different telephone number and the calls are determined by code ringing. Two-party line service is the connection of two main stations and four-party line service is the connection of four main stations, etc.

2. Terms and Conditions

Terminal equipment may be directly connected at the customer premises to the telecommunications network. The equipment must be registered or grandfathered under Part 68 of the FCC's Rules for connection to single line service.

Automatic equipment used on party line service which is incapable of relinquishing the line in an emergency is not permitted.

[1] Party Line Service will only be provided on a temporary basis where facilities for individual line service are not immediately available. When facilities become available, existing customers will be regraded to individual line service. See 5.2.6 for the Telephone Assistance Program credits.
